

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.

2. ELIGIBILITY: Must be 18 years of age or older, as of date of entry. Employees of The Daily Journal ("Sponsor"), the Small Newspaper Group, and their immediate family members and individuals residing in the same household, whether or not related, are not eligible to participate in this contest ("Contest"). By participating, contestants agree to these Official Rules.

3. PROMOTIONAL PERIOD: Pick the Pros begins 9/01/09 and ends 1/03/10 and is broken up into seventeen (17) Contests or one (1) Contest each week for seventeen (17) weeks. A week in the Promotional Period ("Week") begins at 10:00 a.m. Central Time (CT) on Tuesday of a Week and ends 11:59:59 p.m. CT on Friday of the same Week.

4. TO ENTER: The object of Pick the Pros is to amass as many of the possible points as you can. The maximum number of points is the sum of all possible ranking points each Week. This number may vary from Week to Week. There are two ways to enter.

A.) To Enter with an Entry Form from The Daily Journal newspaper: Review the Week's schedule of games listed on the official Pick The Pros entry form and count the total number of games on the form. The total number of games is the highest number of points that a game can be ranked. Decide which game you are most confident of picking a winner and circle the team you project to win. Put the highest-ranking number of points next to that team. Circle the name of your second most confident winner and put the next highest-ranking number of points next to that team and so on down to the one game you are least confident of. For each circled team that wins, you win the points you attributed to that game. No points will be awarded on tie games or in case any game is not played for any reason during its scheduled Week. Finally, fill in the Tie Breaker by entering the total points you think will be scored by both teams in the Week's designated Tie Breaker game. B.) To Enter Online at www.Daily-Journal.com/contests: Log on to <http://daily-journal.com/contests> and click on Pick the Pros.

Limit one entry per person per Week. Any entry form that does not contain a name, e-mail address, etc. will be disqualified. Entries that fail to forecast a winner for each and every game or those entries where a number is not placed or used more than once will be dis-

qualified. Each entry must represent the original work of one entrant. No mechanically reproduced or photocopied entries permitted. Any entries received from any person/address/e-mail address/Week in excess of the limit stated will void the excess entries for that person/address/e-mail address/Week. 5. WINNERS: Winners will be determined by the contestant who amasses the most points with his/her picks each Week. In case of a tie, the Tie Breaker will be utilized. Winner of the Tie Breaker is the contestant who guesses the correct total number of points in the designated Tie Breaker game. If this step fails to produce a winner, a drawing will be held among those contestants still tied. Winners will be notified by phone on the Wednesday after each Week's Contest.

6. PRIZES: The winner of each Week's Contest will receive a \$100 check by mail. Allow 2-3 weeks for delivery of prize. All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner.
